Mandatory information:

- Name, Surname
- Company, Full Address, Working position, e-mail

Technical requirements:

All abstracts should be submitted in MS Word file format

Textual information:

Your abstract should not contain more than 500 words.
The Times New Roman font (10 pt, line spacing 1) has been used.
Do not alter the fonts, margins or header/footer.

Pictures, Tables, Figures and Graphics must be submitted in JPG, EPS, AI, TIFF (recommended resolution 300dpi) graphic file formats separately as an attachment.
